WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

All Public Housing and Section 8 graduating High School seniors or residents that are currently attending college are eligible. The applicant must have a 2.5 GPA and must have lived in Public Housing or Section 8 Assisted Housing for at least one year.

WHAT DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP COVER?

The scholarships will cover tuition fees and books.
